Code of Conduct

Students, regardless of age, are subject to the regulations whilst in the care of members of staff, who act in loco parentis for the duration of the visit. Acceptance of this code implies that both parents/carers and students understand it to be a basic condition of the contract of the activity.

All the rules and regulations that follow are a requirement for the safety of those involved, and the enjoyment of all participating.

1. Behaviour must always reflect the high standards demanded at Eastbrook School as laid out in the school Behaviour Policy, and must always reflect the rules and regulations laid down by the proprietors of any accommodation used.
2. Consideration of other guests and visitors is of paramount importance.
3. Students must take personal responsibility for their possessions at all times and take suitable precautions against theft.
4. Students are required to attend meals on time, and to be present at all roll calls.
5. When students have free time they stay in the groups allocated and a member of staff will remain at a nominated venue throughout that period.
6. The laws, traditions and rules of countries visited must be observed at all times.
7. All trips are non-smoking.
8. There will be no alcohol or spirits taken, bought or consumed on the trip.

Any student contravening these expectations may be sent home at the expense of his/her parent/carers.
